## OUR WORK

AriSEIA was a key contributor to the governor's Arizona Energy Promise Taskforce, advocating for the promotion of clean repowering, expansion of Virtual Power Plant programs, reduction of barriers to distributed solar deployment, and streamlining of permitting. We expand education on solar rights, grid reliability, and utility accountability. AriSEIA is actively shaping local ordinances that ensure clear, consistent, and non-discriminatory rules for solar and battery storage. We also actively participate in utility resource planning processes and rate cases. At the legislature, we monitor all energy related bills and have a dedicated lobbyist to support or oppose bills of particular interest to AriSEIA members. We also endorse pro-solar candidates in the Salt River Project (SRP) board elections.

## ENTITY MEMBERSHIPS – VOTING

Annual dues are based on your organization's **national**, annual revenue. This sliding scale applies to for and not-for-profits. **All memberships run for 12 months from the month they commence.**

- Less than \$1,000,000 national, annual revenue (\$995)
- \$1,000,001–\$3,500,000 national, annual revenue (\$1995)
- \$3,500,001 to \$6,500,00 national, annual revenue (\$3495)
- Greater than \$6,500,00 national, annual revenue (\$4995)
